Parashat Bo El Para'oh

You are the faithful one of My house; fear not, for I have helped you.
I, Adonai, have called you in order to do righteousness, and have supported you with My right hand.

When I had not yet formed you in the belly, I knew you,

Cong. And when you had not yet left the womb, I consecrated you, and made you a prophet for the nations. (Jeremiah 1:5)

Get up early, and go to Hofra⁴, who has mightily piled up words.
I have made his heart heavy, and the heart of his servants, which is extensive,
In order to place these miracles of mine in his midst – [for] he composes taunts.

Cong. His mouth speaks folly; without thought, he makes extensive words.
(Job 35:16)

To multiply my wonders against him, I have hardened his heart,
Until he wear a curse as his garment, and it enter inside him like water.”
[God] intimidated [Pharaoh] with the tenth plague; He first warned him, when he was still in his state of freshness:

Cong. [That] a cruel angel would be dispatched against him. (Proverbs 17:11)

Nisan, with awesome miracles, and newly-made wonders,
Makes God and people happy in its days.
Adonai commanded the progeny of Jeshurun, the nation of holy people:

Cong. This month shall be for you the first of months. (Exodus 12:2)

When Israel went out, they took counsel to ask for the riches of the Ludites,
Silver and gold and embroidered garments – they took, and went on their way.
They carried their dough in joy, as they walked,

Cong. For they were going out of the place of imprisonment, to be kings!
(Ecclesiastes 4:14)

It is still established and guarded for their freedom,
Guarded for the Israelites, for all their generations –

Cong. [He] heals those broken in heart, and bandages their sadness. (Psalms 147:3)

Cantor. For Israel is a child, and I have loved him; and I called my son out of Egypt. (Hosea 11:1)

For Adonai is His people's lot; Jacob is the portion of His inheritance. (Deut. 32:9)

For Yah has chosen Jacob, Israel for His treasured [people]. (Psalms 135:4)

Hear me, O Jacob, and Israel, those called by me: I am He, I am the first, and I am also the last.
(Isaiah 48:12)

Cong. Hear O Israel, Adonai our God is Adonai on His own. (Deuteronomy 6:4)
